As you know, in the UK there has been taking place an enormous upheaval in the limb service which is being re-structured and by 1991, tied into the National Health Service.


We did send samples of Farabloc to the current Disablement Services Authority who are in charge at the moment asking if this could be on offer to our own people as many had obtained great benefit from using it.
